

## **R/V CONNECTICUT DECK CREW**

**76' R/V Connecticut is in need of deck crew late August -November  
Vessel is engaged in general oceanographic operations from NJ- Gulf of Maine.  
Vessel is equipped with dynamic positioning. Cruises last from 2-10 days.**

**Responsibilities:** Deck crew is responsible for assisting in overall operation of vessel. They will oversee deck operations- interface with science party to insure safe deployment and recovery of equipment. Operate deck machinery including cranes, frames, and winches. Hourly engine room checks and assist engineer in routine engine room maintenance. Assist master and mate with wheel house watches. They are responsible for shipboard cleaning and ship board maintenance. This person may be asked to serve as relief mate. Ship can be at sea up to 10 days at a time and maybe away from home port 30 days at a time. Watch schedule is 6hrs on 6 hrs off. Crew may be asked to work more if safety of crew and vessel require it.

**Qualifications:** Should have 2-3 years vessel experience preferably on board commercial vessels. Heavy equipment operation and strong mechanical aptitude preferred. 100 Ton Mate or AB and STCW Basic are minimum requirements.
